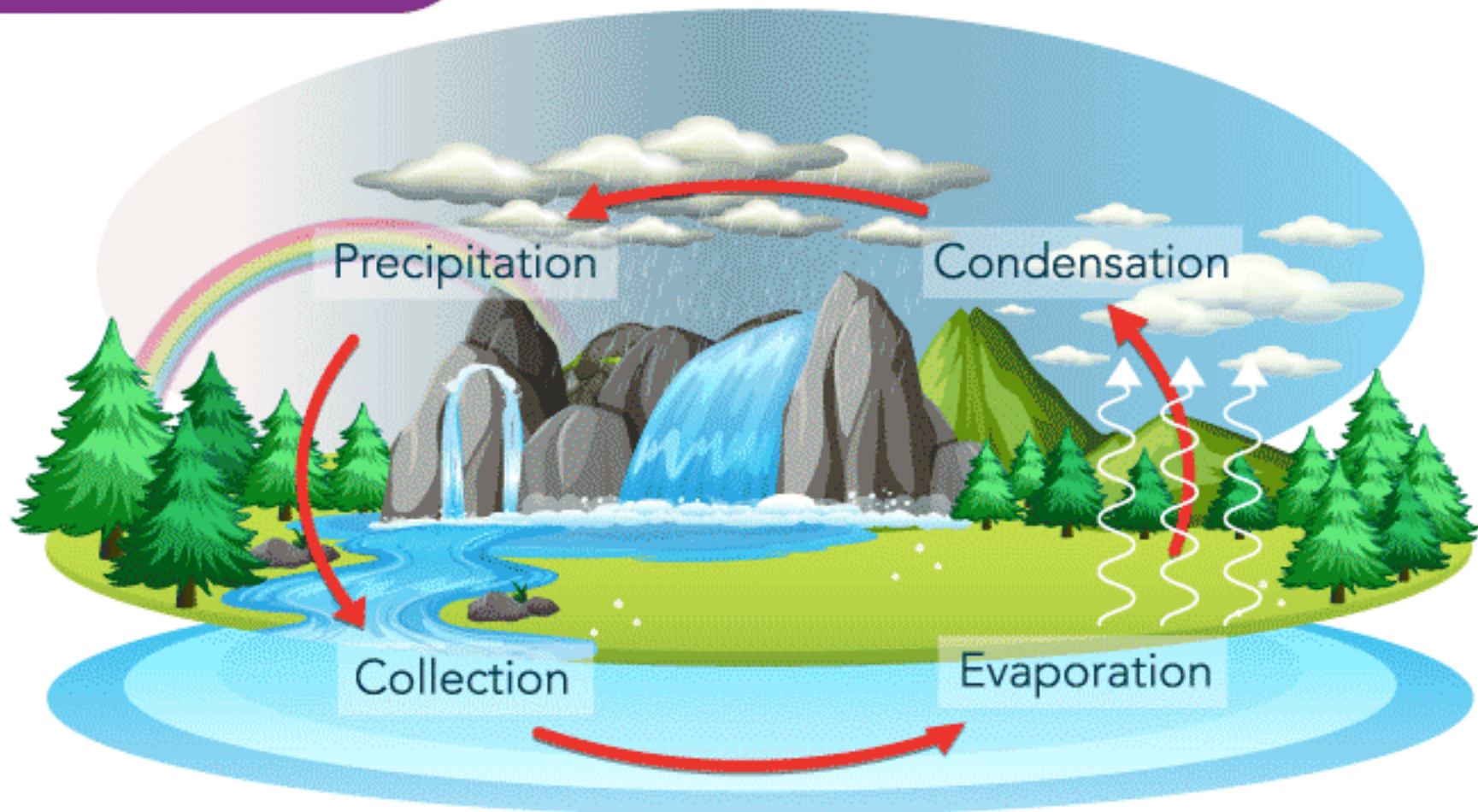




THE OXYGEN CYCLE
