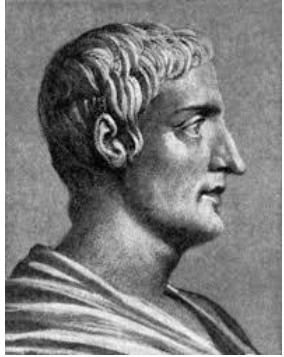

~Matt. 16:13-14

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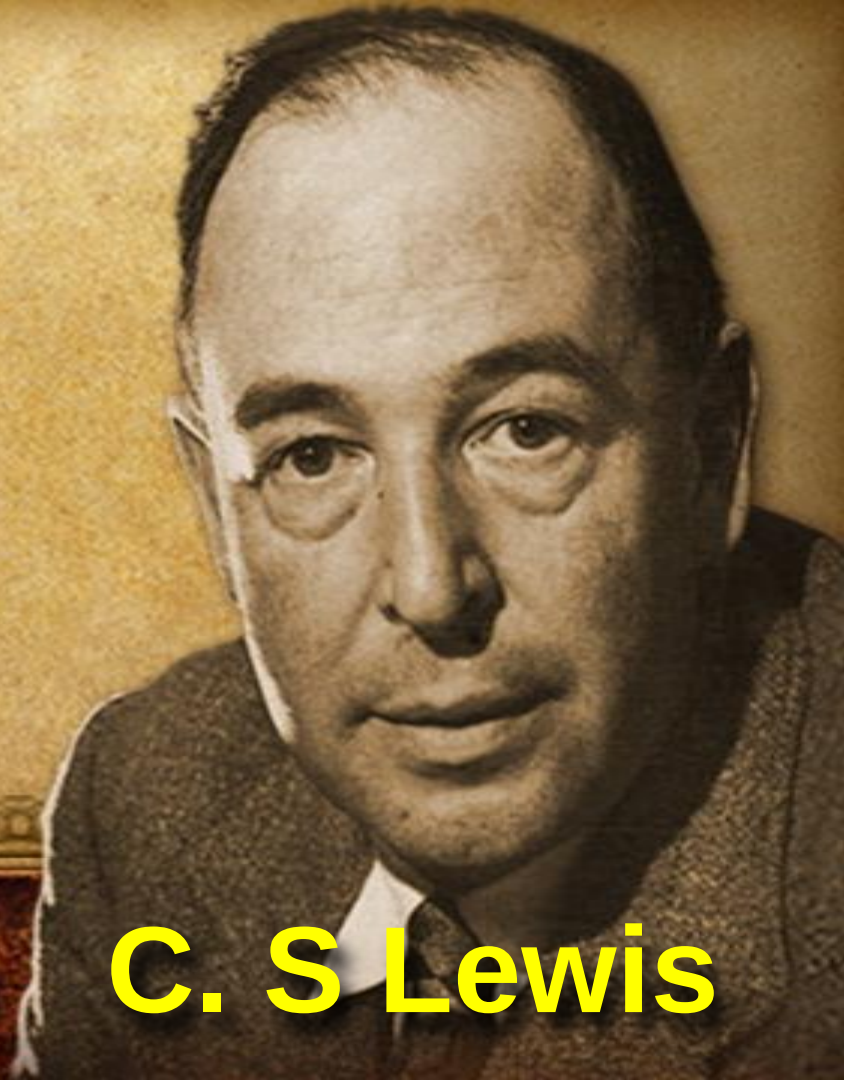
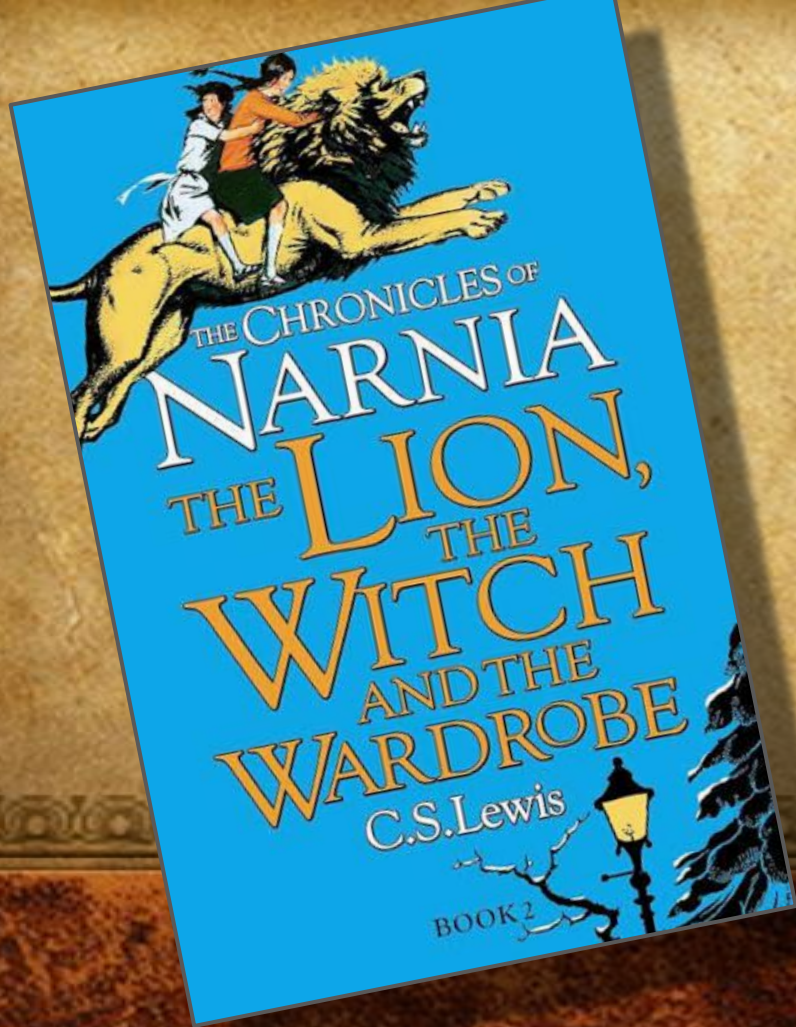
